

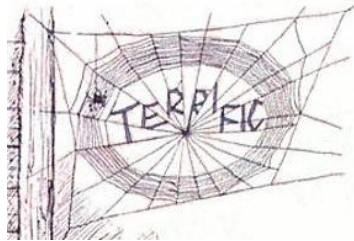

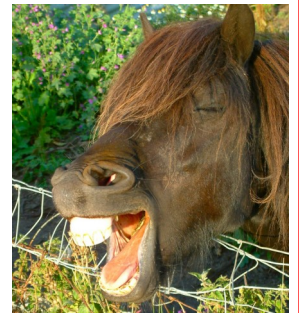
Grooming

Summer is here and dog grooming is entering into a very busy period. Grooming appointments with Nikki need to be made well in advance in order to secure a spot, so please don't leave booking your pooch's hair day to the last minute.



Horse teeth

A horse's teeth consciously grow!! That being said horses need their teeth floated to keep sharp points from occurring and hurting their mouth. In a horse's mouth when they eat, especially when they eat grain they chew with a side to side motion, this unfortunately develops sharp points. The sharp points will occur on the upper maxillary arcade against the cheek and on the lower arcade against the tongue. The sharp points, if not filled down, can cause sores and even an abscess. This can be very painful for the animal! Horses should have their teeth checked every year to see if they need a dental.
